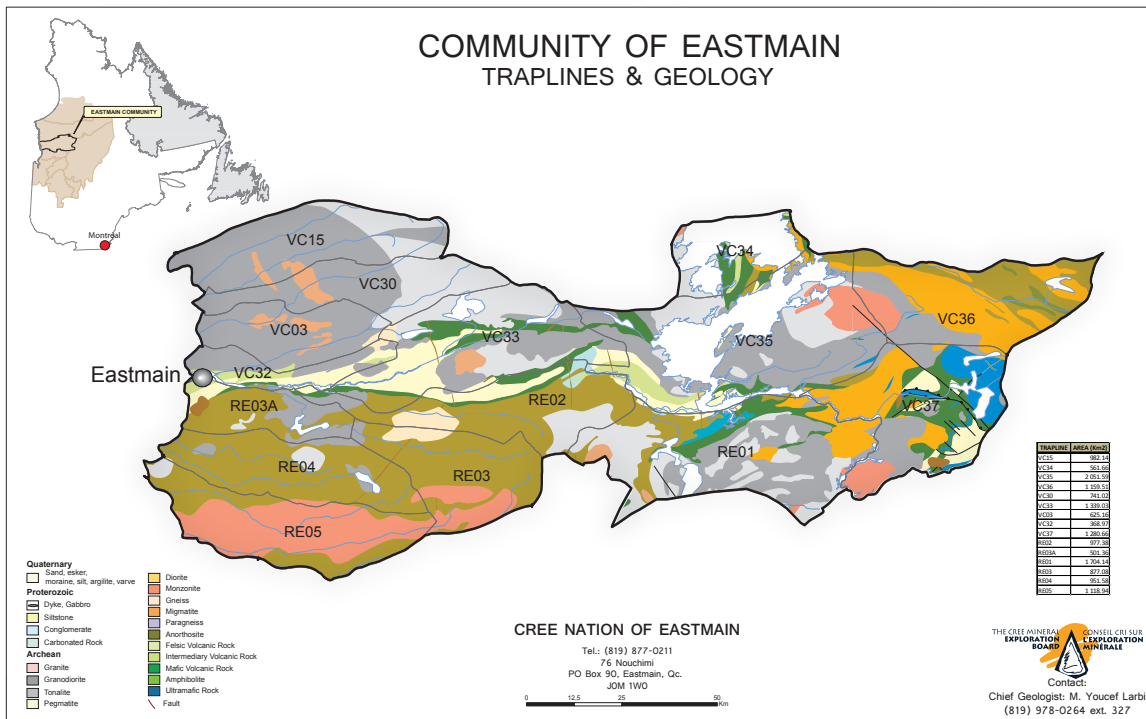

4. CREE NATION OF EASTMAIN TRAPLINES

4.1. Exploration Activity and Mineral Resources Potential

The Eastmain traplines are on the La Grande and Nemiscau subprovinces.



Substances of interest to exploration companies and prospectors include beryllium (Be), bismuth (Bi), copper (Cu), diamond (C), gold (Au), lithium (Li), molybdenum (Mo), silver (Ag), tantalum (Ta), tellurium (Te), and zinc (Zn).
