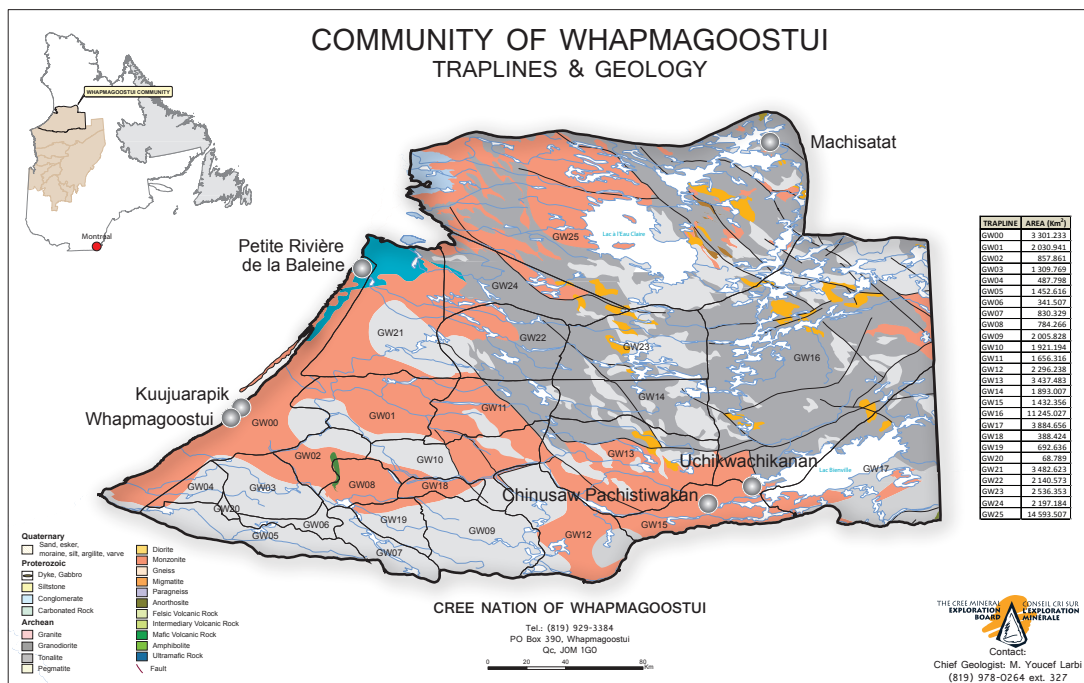

## 11. WHAPMAGOOSTUI FIRST NATION TRAPLINES

### 11.1. Exploration Activity and Mineral Resources Potential

The Whapmagoostui traplines are on the Bienville subprovince.



Substances of interest to exploration companies and prospectors include gold (Au), iron (Fe), lead (Pb), silver (Ag), and zinc (Zn).

### 11.2. Highlights

- **Targa Exploration** is exploring for gold in Quebec, with recent work focusing on promising gold-in-till anomalies near Whapmagoostui, involving till sampling, heavy mineral concentrate analysis, and initial drilling in late 2025 to test a 7km trend, showing visible gold and potential for significant discoveries in this remote northern region.
- **SIRIOS Resources** did a light sampling, targeting gold and Lithium.

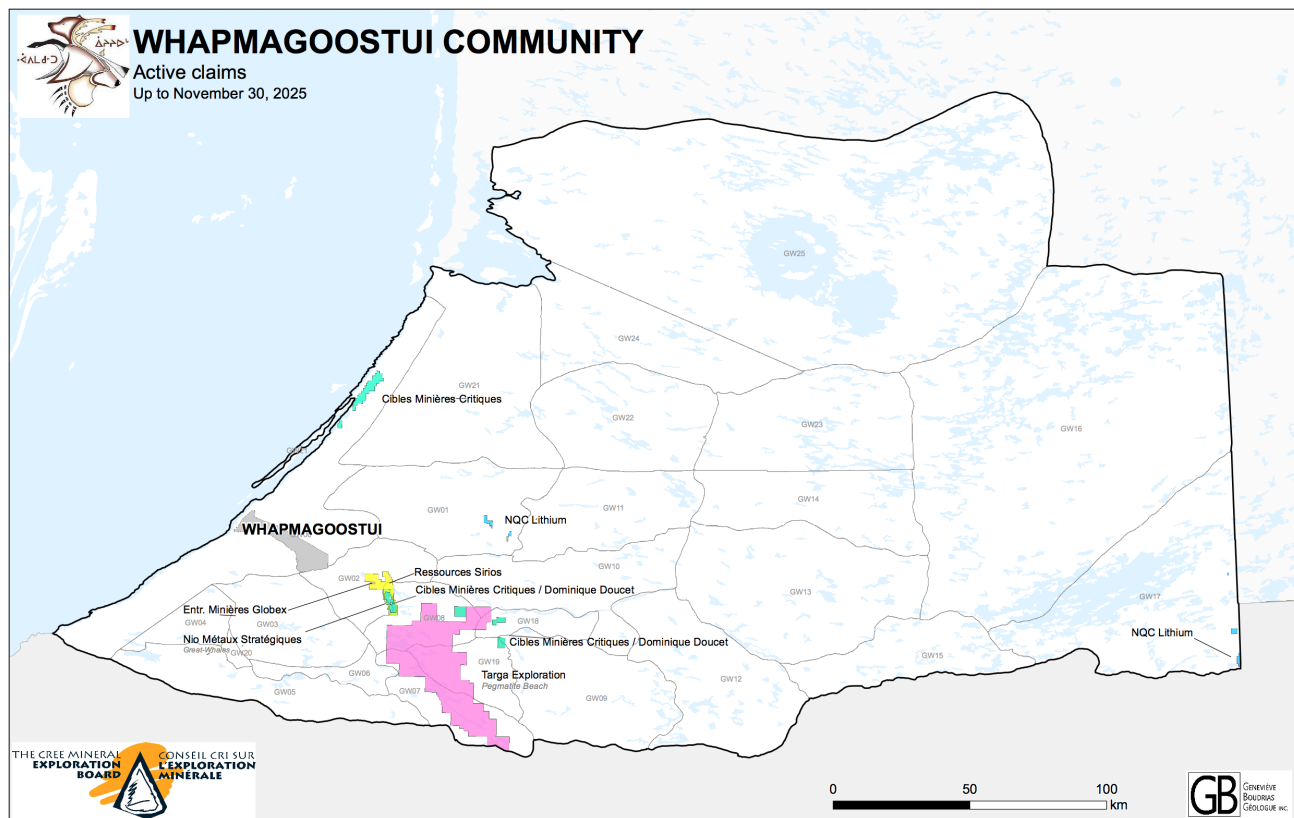

**Base metals** include copper (Cu), nickel (Ni), chromium (Cr), cobalt (Co), molybdenum (Mo), lead (Pb), and zinc (Zn). Iron (Fe) includes titanium (Ti) and vanadium (V).

**Platinum Group Elements** include iridium (Ir), osmium (Os), palladium (Pd), platinum (Pt), rhodium (Rh), and ruthenium (Ru). **Rare metals** include Lithium (Li), beryllium (Be), bismuth (Bi), niobium (Nb), tantalum (Ta), tellurium (Te) and tungsten (W). **Rare Earth Elements** include cerium (Ce), dysprosium (Dy), erbium (Er), europium (Eu), gadolinium (Gd), holmium (Ho), lanthanum (La), lutetium (Lu), neodymium, (Nd) praseodymium (Pr), promethium (Pm), samarium (Sm), scandium (Sc), terbium (Tb), thulium ( Tm ), ytterbium (Yb) and yttrium (Y).
